At our last Stated Communication a resolution was read and approved by the Craft to amend our By-Laws to allow changes to our Degree Fees. The following is your official notice of these proposed changes.

This is Resolution to amend section 9.01, FEES FOR THE DEGREES AND AFFILIATION, of the By-Laws for Olin S Wright Masonic Lodge No. 79, located at 803 W. Mahoney Street in Plant City, FL.

### CURRENT WORDING

The fee for the Background Check shall be <u>\$15.00</u>: for Initiation shall be <u>\$50.00</u>: for Passing<u>\$50.00</u>: and for Raising **\$50.00**. In every case the fee shall be paid to the Secretary in advance, without which no petition or application shall be read or announced, and in every case of rejection the fee shall be promptly returned from the treasury, upon the Master's Order. (ACCEPTED AND APPROVED SEPTEMBER 28, 1981).

### AMENDED TO READ

The fee for the Background Check shall be **\$15.00**: for Initiation shall be **\$100.00**: for Passing**\$100.00**: and for Raising **\$100.00**. In every case the fee shall be paid to the Secretary in advance, without which no petition or application shall be read or announced, and in every case of rejection the fee shall be promptly returned from the treasury, upon the Master's Order. (SUBMITTED TO THE CRAFT SEPTEMBER 7, 2023)

Final consideration and a vote by written secret ballot for final approval will be taken at the Stated Meeting on Thursday, October 5, 2023. Please plan to attend.
